**The following questions were asked at the pre-submittal meeting:**

**Question 1:** In the RFP documents Section 3.3 states "No used, reconditioned or refurbished equipment shall be placed during the term of this contract at any SAHA location that is more than five years old." We can take an older machine and refurbish it with new internals to be as energy efficient as a new machine and make the outside look as new. Would SAHA allow this?

**Answer 1:** Section 3.3 is modified as follows:

**3.3 Equipment:** The Contractor is required to provide all new or fully refurbished equipment at each location upon start of service. The equipment shall be the most efficient models available in terms of energy and water usage and if applicable and/or available from the vending machine manufacturing industry shall be "Energy Star" rated. No used, reconditioned or refurbished equipment shall be placed during the term of this contract at any SAHA location that is more than five years old except that SAHA will allow a machine originally produced more than five years ago provided that the machine has been 100% refurbished with all new internal mechanical and electrical operating systems so that it is as energy efficient as models less than five years old and the exterior has been made to look as new. Any such machine must display a tag or decal indicating the date the refurbishment was completed. Place data and spec sheets under Tab 9.

**Question 2:** Section 1.7 lists the term as 2 years with 3 one year renewals, would SAHA consider a straight five (5) year contract?

**Answer 2:** SAHA will not offer an outright five (5) year contract for this type of service; however, subject to good performance and continued need by SAHA the contract has the potential for a full five (5) year span.



**Add the following definitions to Section 1:**

- 1.3.19 Used :** Previously used or placed equipment that has not been rebuilt, reconditioned or refurbished but is still reliably operational and not prone to malfunction or failure.
- 1.3.20 Reconditioned:** Used equipment that has been rebuilt to a serviceable condition utilizing new and or used parts but has not been upgraded from its original manufacturing specifications.
- 1.3.21 Refurbished:** Equipment that has been made to be as new and updated to the latest energy efficiency and technology. This includes the complete replacement of all operating systems, mechanical and electrical controls and exterior finish paint, panels, decals, etc. to bring the unit to the latest standards.

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
