Question 1: Page 18 Section 3.24 Regarding frequency of fertilizer application for grass and lawn areas, tree care, ground cover and shrubs. Is fertilizations requested per this item be included in the Routine maintenance fee 1st. item of pricing? It is also included in additional pricing in item # 4 chemically fertilize grass, shrubs, trees ground cover beds, Due to this two items requesting the same it appears as if it is as extra per request and not part of the routine service cut.

Answer 1: It is part of the cost for Routine Maintenance Service Fee Per Cut to be done as stated twice per year. We are asking for a separate cost in item # 4 Chemically fertilize grass, shrubs, trees, ground cover beds for any additional services that may be required..

Question 2: Page 16 Section 3.23.1 Bullet Point # 11 talks about mulch Provide all trees on the property with a trunk 8" or less with a mulch ring of shredded bark the use of alternative materials for mulch requires the prior written approval of the SAHA CA property manager or their designees. It is clear that alternative mulch materials can be used with approval, please confirm that for bidding purposes all bidding contractors should use shredded bark as the mulch to be placed.

Answer 1: That is correct, for bidding purposes all Contractors shall use shredded bark.

Please note the following change.

Refer to Page 16 Section 3.23.1, Bullet Point # 8

Delete this paragraph in its entirety:

Administer a program of fire ant treatment during every service visit by a licensed technician or a technician under the licensee's supervision as allowed by law and regulations. The program shall include spot treating every mound or colony discovered during each routine service.

Replace with the following paragraph:

The program shall include spot treating every mound or colony discovered during each routine service by a licensed technician or a technician under the licensee's supervision as allowed by law and regulations.
