The Closing Date for RFQ 1009-990-25-3307 is hereby extended until 11:00AM January 26, 2011.

Question 1: What are the prerequisites for the Childcare Training Program?

Answer 1: The prerequisite to the childcare training program for residents are that they have a High School Diploma or enter a GED concurrently while attending the childcare training program and that they do not have any serious felonies (misdemeanors may be okay depending on the severity).

Question 2: What is the relationship with the contractor and the case manager for each property?

Answer 2: Contractor should collaborate with Case Manager for recruitment of residents for all MTW initiatives.

Question 3: Will we have access to case files or file information so that we can better determine who is eligible for the listed programs?

Answer 3: Case files will be confidential; however, contractor will be able to meet with Case Managers regularly to receive information on requirements for a particular initiative and contractor initially will not have to know who (resident) is eligible as the case manager will make referrals according to eligibility criteria and their assessment during holistic case management. If contractor does the recruitment and identifies the resident, they will work with case manager to determine eligibility.

Question 4: Does only the bidder fill out the profile of firm form or do they need one for each subcontractor as well?

Answer 4: A profile of firm will need to be completed for each subcontractor.

Question 5: What specific metrics are being used currently to measure crime/drug use in these communities?

Answer 5: We are currently utilizing information provided by our local police department.
