Question 1: Under Contractor Responsibilities: we have reviewed paragraphs 3.3.1, 3.3.2 and 3.3.5 which speak to eligibility and acceptance of eligible families into the Choice Voucher Housing program. Given the assumption that "the Contractor," will accept all eligible referrals into the Choice Voucher Housing program from SAHA's waiting list," we question if there is any flexibility afforded a specialty facility, such as the Center for Health Care Services, to limit the number of vouchers provided to a total of 50, and to ensure that these are provided to those with a diagnosed mental illness or disability.

Answer 1: The 200 vouchers are being set aside for homeless people in San Antonio to include individuals with mental illnesses or other serious health problems. At this time, it is SAHA's **goal** to partner with an independent contractor who can assist in administering all 200 of the vouchers currently available. SAHA reserves the right to award to a single contractor or multiple Contractors at SAHA's sole discretion.
